Students receiving CLEP credit for a course cannot take the equivalent course at IWU or have existing credits for the course.

Per the University Catalog:

*Credit through examination (CLEP/DANTES/Advanced Placement) may only be awarded with official test scores from an official testing center and an Indiana Wesleyan University individual assessment. The **maximum number of credits awarded shall be limited to a total of 40 semester credits for the baccalaureate degree and 18 semester credits for the associate degree**, and ordinarily will not be applied to upper-division requirements in the major (junior and senior levels). It is the responsibility of the student to obtain approval from the appropriate division for the application of credits to the majors.*

***Prior approval from the Registration & Academic Services Office (RAS) is required.** Only those CLEP tests on the above approved list will be evaluated for credit. Credit for each test will be given after an official evaluation is conducted by the Registration & Academic Services office.*

The recommended semester hours listed above are subject to change based on new ACE recommendations.

Courses may be added or removed based on continued review from the Academic Affairs Council.
