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Executive Summary: The End of Program Survey was given to graduating students from three Christian college adult programs. This analysis compares the responses of African American and Caucasian students. African Americans are less likely to be in online programs. They are more highly motivated by the convenience and Christian emphasis of the program. African Americans are slightly more satisfied with the program than Caucasian students. African Americans report high satisfaction with the spiritual aspects of the program and appear to be more highly impacted by the Christian focus of faculty and curriculum.
