**TRANSFER AGREEMENT**

Ivy Tech Community College graduates who have completed the appended Associate of Science degree program of study in Criminal Justice may transfer and apply a minimum of 60 credits to the requirements for Indiana Wesleyan University's Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Criminal Justice. This agreement is designed to serve Ivy Tech students well and guide their course selection at IWU.
