The Ministerial Student Aid Program is a loan program administered by The Wesleyan Church through the Department of Education & The Ministry. The loan only becomes a grant as the recipient serves The Wesleyan Church under a qualifying appointment. Applicants should understand that in requesting aid from this program they are applying for a loan, which must be either repaid or cancelled through service.

General Stipulations for Eligibility

For Ministerial Students and Ministerial Candidates

1. **Local Church Membership.** The student must be a covenant member of a local Wesleyan church.
2. **District Approval.** The student is to consult with and be examined and approved by the District Board of Ministerial Development (DBMD), and must be granted the status of ministerial student, licensed minister or ordained/commissioned minister by the district conference (or by the District Board of Administration in the interim of district conference sessions) prior to the beginning of the semester in which aid is sought. Initial certification and subsequent annual re-certification by the DBMD through its chairperson or secretary as to the district status of the student for the current school year is required.
3. **Dept. of Education & The Ministry Enrollment.** The student must be enrolled with Education & The Ministry. Enrollment forms are found at www.wesleyan.org/EM.

A) Institutional Approval

An official of the school at which the student is enrolled must certify:

1. the number of school semester hours for which the student is enrolled,
2. total accumulated semester credit hours,
3. the student's classification,
4. the student's grade point average, which must be at least 2.0 on a four-point scale.

B) Status of Student

1. Students are to attend an approved seminary or Wesleyan graduate program.
2. The student must be a member and ministerial student of the North American General Conference, training for church ministry, and enrolled in a major that includes the courses required for ordination.
3. The student must indicate his/her desire and intention to serve under appointment by one of the districts of The Wesleyan Church in the U. S. or Canada in a capacity where cancellation can occur (see D:1:c).
4. Aid may begin in the junior year of college and be granted for a maximum of five full years – that is the junior and senior years of college and three additional years of theological training, including any combination of the following which does not exceed three years: a fifth year in college, or graduate level work in theology leading to a one-year, two-year, or three-year degree. (see C:2)
5. Aid is available for special sessions (summer or between semesters) subject to the availability of funds.
6. While receiving aid, the student shall report by the fifth week of each semester to the properly designated person at the Wesleyan college/university concerning his/her church attendance and involvement for that semester. College/university personnel shall cooperate with the General Director of Education & The Ministry in counseling students into meaningful local church relationships (giving priority to Wesleyan church attendance and service) as a condition for continued student aid.
7. A District Certification (status) form is included with each application package and is required annually. The student should send this to the chair of his/her District Board of Ministerial Development for signature. This form should be signed **following** the approval for district appointment of the student for the **current year for which aid is requested**. Renewal applications require this form annually.

C) Loan-Grant

1. The amount of loan-grant is determined each year on the basis of funds available by a formula approved by the General Board.
2. The loan-grant funds are distributed on a per-hour basis, with a maximum of ninety (90) semester hours on the graduate level.

D) Repayment of Loan-Grant

1. Cancellation of loan:
 - a) For each year of full-time district appointment in The Wesleyan Church (Sept 1 through Aug 31) **following studies**, twenty percent (20%) of the loan will be cancelled after the service is rendered and reported. Cancellation cannot be given in the same church year that one receives loan-grant funds.
 - b) Each student is considered as having a single loan-grant account, though it may be divided into undergraduate and graduate funds. If a student has an undergraduate loan-grant and enrolls in graduate theological training while pastoring full-time, cancellation will be granted for the undergraduate portion of the loan-grant.
 - c) Report of service shall be made annually by the recipient of the loan on the annual status form available on the Department of Education & The Ministry's website: www.wesleyan.org/em.
 - d) Appointment by the district must be to ministerial service (as defined by the church; see *Discipline 3250*) under employment by The Wesleyan Church, or by one of its approved institutions. Appointment to interchurch services **does not** qualify for cancellation.
2. Postponement of repayments may be granted if the student continues graduate studies for work in The Wesleyan Church, but is either not eligible for further loans or does not desire the aid. The student must apply annual for this postponement on the annual status form.
3. For those who do not serve in The Wesleyan church after graduation or termination of their ministerial studies, **whether because of personal choices or from lack of opportunity**, repayment of the loan shall begin.
4. If a borrower fails to keep faith with their commitment to this agreement, we reserve the right to send an account to collections.
5. After termination of training, it is always the duty of the recipient of a loan-grant to keep the office of the Department of Education & The Ministry informed of any address or appointment change or change in contact information.

Procedures for Applying for Graduate Loan-Grant First-time Applicants

1. The student must complete and submit the application form to Indiana Wesleyan University.
2. The student should fill out the top section of the District Certification Form and send it to the Chairperson of his/her district board of ministerial development (DBMD). This should be done following the annual district conference just before the school year. Your DMBD must complete, sign and date the bottom section of this form and return it to Indiana Wesleyan University.
3. The Certificate of Enrollment's top section must be completed by the student and then given Indiana Wesleyan University for its completion.
4. Complete the Institutional Authorization form and give it to Indiana Wesleyan University for filing in the institution's office.
5. Request transcript(s) of all post high school work through the end of the last term of academic work completed.
6. Once your school has all the above paperwork, Indiana Wesleyan University will mail your complete application packet to the Department of Education & The Ministry for processing of the check. When your check arrives, sign the promissory note enclosed with the check and return it **immediately** to the proper office of your educational institution.

Procedures for Renewing Your Graduate Loan-Grant

1. When requesting additional loan-grant funds, the student must complete and submit a Financial Aid Renewal Application form and turn it in to Indiana Wesleyan University.
2. District Certification is needed once a year only, generally in the fall after district conference.
