The Athletic Training program at Indiana Wesleyan University seeks to prepare the program graduate for certification and service in the athletic training profession. Certification is a national process lead by the Board of Certification (BOC) and includes challenging a national examination. Licensure/registration procedures vary by state. The National Athletic Trainers' Association has collected agency information for each state (<u>https://members.nata.org/gov/state/regulatory-boards/map.cfm</u>). The procedure in the state of Indiana is:

Following successful completion of the IWU Athletic Training program, the program graduate achieves BOC certification and Indiana state licensure by the following steps. 1. Apply for and pass the BOC Examination.

2. Apply for licensure through the Athletic Training Committee of the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency.
