The <u>Bachelor to Doctor of Nursing Practice Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner</u> program at Indiana Wesleyan University seeks to prepare the program graduate for licensure/certification and service in the <u>Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner</u> profession. After passing the certification exam, the graduate may apply for licensure to practice as a Nurse Practitioner by contacting their state board of nursing.
