

To the maximum extent practicable, and in a manner of the institution's choosing, each institution must disclose on the institution's Internet course schedule used for preregistration and registration purposes, the International Standard Book Number (ISBN) and retail price information of required and recommended textbooks and supplemental materials for each course listed. If the ISBN is not available, the institution must include in the Internet course schedule the author, title, publisher, and copyright date for the textbook or supplemental material.

Slingshot Pro, a service of Slingshot, is available to help students easily obtain required textbooks throughout their program at IWU. This service is automatically provided but students can opt out and secure books elsewhere. Slingshot Customer Service can assist with choosing the best option or opting out. The default option is "Rent Used" as it is the most affordable option. For more information go to https://indwes.slingshotedu.com.

Upon arriving at the landing page, click on the "Buy Books" tab. You may then choose several different methods to locate your textbook information. You may choose based on your enrolled schedule, search by ISBN, or use the Search by Course tab.



Occasionally, courses are open for registration but the textbooks and materials have not been chosen by the faculty. In these cases a message saying "to be determined" will show in the search. If you register for a course and the textbook information has not been posted, you will receive an automatic email update when the textbook information is available.
