

Educator Preparation Provider: Employment Rates

In the EPP Annual Completer Survey, respondents report whether they are employed as full-time teachers. Indiana Wesleyan University (IWU) uses these responses to calculate employment rates for initial program completers. For advanced programs, completers indicate whether they are employed within their specialty field, and IWU uses this information to determine employment rates for advanced program completers.

It is also important to note that, across both initial and advanced programs, some completers may choose not to be employed at the time of the survey. For example, individuals completing an advanced program in school administration may elect to remain in classroom teaching roles and pursue administrative positions at a later date.
