Licensure/certification procedures vary by state. The procedure in the state of Indiana to become a Licensed Addictions Counseling Associate (LACA) is:

1. Download, complete, and submit the Licensed Addiction Counsellor application from the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency (<https://www.in.gov/pla/4015.htm>).
2. The Indiana Professional Licensing Agency will authorize taking one of the following certification exams.
 - a. Alcohol & Drug Counselors (ADC) examination administered by the [International Certification and Reciprocity Consortium](#) (IC & RC).
 - b. National Certified Addiction Counselor II (NCAC II) administered by the [NAADAC-National Certification Commission for Addiction Professionals](#) (NAADAC-NCC AP).
3. After passage of the examination, the Indiana Professional Licensing Agency will issue the Indiana Addictions Counseling Associate state license.
