 for Traditional Students**

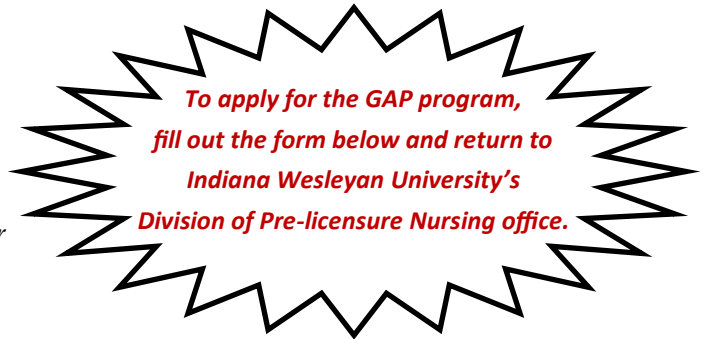


A direct entry program, **Guaranteed Acceptance Pathway (GAP)** is available for high school students who meet the eligibility requirements.

- ◆ **Select high school students** are eligible to apply for the GAP in the IWU School of Nursing (SON).
- ◆ **Guaranteed Admission** – we reserve you a spot so that when you are done with the prerequisites as outlined below, you can jump right in to clinical nursing.
- ◆ **Streamlined pathway** into nursing clinical coursework
- ◆ **No requirement to apply to the clinical nursing program** as all other students do between the freshman and sophomore years.

Students who are eligible for the GAP Pathway:

- High school seniors with a cumulative GPA of 3.5 on a 4.0 scale
- Students who are fully accepted at Indiana Wesleyan University as a full-time, first-time freshman (not available to transfer students)
- Students with an ACT score of 22 or higher, or RSAT of 1110 or higher
- Students whose high school coursework includes 4 years of English & 3 years of math (including algebra) and natural sciences (including one chemistry and one biology course)
