The Bachelor of Science and Master of Science in Accounting programs offered by the DeVoe School of Business have received a separate ACBSP accreditation in accounting. This accreditation is in addition to being recognized along with the other accredited business programs.

State boards of accountancy are being encouraged to adopt rules that allow students graduating from programs that have attained a separate accounting accreditation to receive less scrutiny of transcripts and to be determined to have met the recommended requirements to sit for the Certified Public Accountant (CPA) examination. Students graduating from the DeVoe School of Business accounting programs who are interested in sitting for the CPA examination are encouraged to contact their state board of accountancy to determine the rules used for reviewing transcripts from an ACBSP accredited accounting program.

## Standards of Excellence.

ACBSP ignites a standard of excellence for business education accreditation through student involvement and achievement, innovative curriculum development and research-based teaching methods, as well as setting accreditation standards based on the Baldrige Education Criteria for Performance Excellence. Unlike other accrediting bodies, students are recognized as major stakeholders in setting ACBSP standards.

Employers place a higher value on candidates who have graduated from a business school that follows the ACBSP standards of excellence.

## Student Advantages.

### Transfer Credits More Easily

Students completing a two-year accredited program **find it easier to transfer earned credits to four-year institutions** for their baccalaureate degree. In pursuing advanced degrees, courses and credits from an accredited school are often more frequently accepted by other institutions.

### Access to Entrepreneurial Initiatives

ACBSP business schools **promote close links with business and entrepreneurial initiatives**, as exemplified by its relationship with Enactus. This helps you gain practical experience and network with employers.

### Membership and Connection

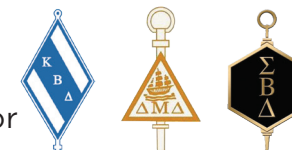

### Leadership Recognition

- Students can be recognized for leadership within the business honor society on campus including Enactus team, FBLA-Phi Beta Lambda, Delta Epsilon Chi-DECA, Delta Mu Delta, Sigma Beta Delta, or Kappa Beta Delta.
