# Admission Requirements

- Proof of high school diploma or transcript, or GED certification.
- Official transcripts from all previous college or university study at regionally accredited colleges or universities or an institution accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education.
- Prior completion of at least 60 transferable credit hours from a regionally accredited college or university or an institution accredited by the Association for Biblical Higher Education is required before the student is eligible to start the RN-BSN program.
- A maximum of 40 credit hours may be earned through the assessed learning process toward the required 60 credits required to start the RN-BSN program. Prior learning assessed through this process includes: non-regionally accredited college and university credits, licenses and professional certifications, professional development, and lifelong learning essays.
- Proof of current **unencumbered** RN licensure;
- An overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 from all previous study. If an applicant's GPA is below 2.0, the student may be admitted on a probationary basis, as established by the guidelines of the college


