This data was collected for 17 of the 19 students that graduated. Also the descriptions to the left are very vague (per Mark’s comment).
4. Students will demonstrate multicultural awareness in clinical practice.	a. Students’ post tests on Multicultural Competency Scale show 33% improvement (Multicultural Counseling Course); b. mean scores on multicultural skill competency section of students’ last semester final internship evaluation will be 3.0-5.0.	a. 1.21 b. 2.35	Note on a. This data was based off the Multicultural Comp post-test on blackboard. Of the 19 students data was collected on only 5 students. Four students were no longer on blackboard and the rest (10) didn’t take the post-test. I couldn’t really show an improvement since only 1 of the 5 students actually took the pre-test. That score was a 1.58 on the pre-test and a 15.69 on the post-test. (These findings may not be what you really wanted to show) Note on b. This data is based on 17 of the 19 graduates. I didn’t have data for 2 of

			them. Also 6 of those 17 had n/a's marked for questions 2, 3, & 5.

Students will demonstrate professional integrity	a. mean of student scores on clinical Integrity section of Final Internship Evaluation will be 3.1 or greater on a 5.0 scale; b. mean score on #46 of employer survey will be 3.5 or above c. no substantiated breaches in ethics or law in academic year	a. 2.44 b. c.	a. Change wording of 5a from clinical integrity to ethics. Also a note on a's findings. Out of the 19 graduates data could only be collected for 12 because 2 were not found and 5 were MFT students and there is no evaluation of personal characteristics on the final evaluation form. Therefore, this score is based on 12 students.
