

ARC LEADERSHIP CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

Beginning in 2022, The Talent Ladder, a division of Indiana Wesleyan University, has been selected to be the educational partner of The Salvation Army – Adult Rehabilitation Centers to offer the ARC Leadership Certificate Program.

This opportunity has been designed for: BOTH ARC OFFICERS & STAFF MEMBERS

This 8-month program is offered in a cohort structure and is available to students from within the Central Territory. Division/Territory approval is required for students to participate in the program. The program of study is comprised of four required courses (a total of 12 credit hours), using both hybrid and online learning delivery modes. It includes 2 hybrid courses delivered as one-week intensives (in person) and supplemented with on-line learning. One hybrid course concentrates on Individual and Group Spiritual Counseling and the other on Operations and Finances with an ARC store. The program also includes two 100% online courses covering specific practice content.
