

THE DEVOE PATHWAY

A FIVE-STEP GUIDE FROM ADMISSION TO GRADUATION

In the DeVoe Division of Business, we want to equip you to rise to your unique, God-given calling. Below is a brief outline of what your path through the DeVoe Division of Business will look like. Check out how we partner with you in your journey to—and after—graduation!

STEP 1 PRE-ADMISSION

This is where your journey with the DeVoe Division of Business begins.

- **WELCOME PACKET** When you declare a business major, you will receive a welcome packet that includes a plan for your time here, your advisor contact information, our program outcomes and a divisional promotional item with our yearly verse.
- **ADVISING MEETINGS** Your advisor—a professor in the DeVoe Division of Business—will meet with you every semester to discuss class options, internship possibilities and career goals.
- FOUNDATIONS CLASS Foundations of Business is designed to give you a taste of each major to help you decide which area you are drawn to.

 We also aim to enroll you in your major principles class as soon as you are able (i.e. Principles of Marketing).

STEP 2 ADMISSION

Admission into the division is typically done at the end of your second year. Requirments for admission are

- COMPLETION OF ALL CORE CLASSES
- · AN INTERVIEW WITH YOUR ADVISOR
- AN ESSAY

After admission you get to take upper-level business classes.

STEP 3 INTERNSHIPS

We believe hands-on experience is one of the best ways to be equipped for a successful, lifelong career. All students get to apply their learning in a supervised field of study. Here's what you can expect:

- BEFORE Obtain official approval from your advisor after finding an internship that interests you and aligns with your major.
- **DURING** Log 150 hours of work during your internship, using your advisor as a resource throughout to maximize your experience.
- AFTER Reflect on how your time in class prepared you for the internship and what more you can learn to prepare for your career.

In addition to your internship, we provide other experiential learning opportunities, such as speakers, field trips, and community service, that encourage networking, innovation and engagement.

STEP 4 CAREER CHOICES

As you step closer to graduation, our faculty will help guide you through the job search process. We highlight job offers to acknowledge our students' successes and show current students that the work is worth it in the end.

STEP 5 GRADUATION

Upon graduation, you and your classmates will be honored for completing your path through the DeVoe Division of Business. We hold an annual senior awards banquet that recognizes all that our seniors have accomplished.

POST-GRADUATION
