Travel Arrangements

(The Student Teacher is responsible for completing all travel arrangements.)

- A. Satisfaction and Safety Issues
- B. Passport and Visa: application process / cost / receipt timeline, etc.
- C. Navigating or changing airplanes and/or airports.
- D. *Return trip in the event of illness and/or inability to adjust to the new Living and/or instructional environment: personal cost.
*An alternative stateside placement may/may not be secured.
- E. IWU medical/evacuation insurance package: type/cost/coverage.
- F. School of Teacher Education placement fee. (Honorarium purposes)

Living Arrangements

(The student teacher is made aware of the housing and transportation arrangements prior to departing the US.)
